Summary: An amendment to require the Comptroller General of the United States to consider the effect of the Act on United States manufacturers that are industrial users of imported products.

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2378
OFFERED BY MR. CAMP OF MICHIGAN**

Amend section 3(b) (page 5, line 19 through page
6, line 2) to read as follows:

1 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re-
2 quired by subsection (a) shall include a description of the
3 extent to which—

4 (1) United States industries that have been ma-
5 terially injured by reason of imports of subject mer-
6 chandise produced in foreign countries with fun-
7 damentally undervalued currencies have received re-
8 lief under title VII of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19
9 U.S.C. 1671 et seq.), as amended by this Act; and

10 (2) United States industries that are industrial
11 users of subject merchandise produced in foreign
12 countries with fundamentally undervalued currencies
13 have been adversely affected by the imposition of the
14 relief described in paragraph (1).
