H.R. 1172

A bill to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to include on the Internet Web site of the Department of Veterans Affairs a list of organizations that provide scholarships to veterans and their survivors

As ordered reported by the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs on June 10, 2009

H.R. 1172 would require the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to provide and maintain on its Web site information regarding scholarships that are available to veterans and family members of deceased veterans. Information to be provided on the Web site would include a list of organizations offering scholarships and a link to their Web sites. VA would also be required to notify schools and other organizations of the opportunity to be listed on the Web site. CBO estimates that implementing the bill would have no significant impact on the federal budget.

H.R. 1172 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would impose no costs on state, local, or tribal governments.
