H.R. 5414 would authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to sell 3 acres of land in the Francis Marion National Forest near Bonneau, South Carolina, to the First Baptist Church of Bonneau. Proceeds from the sale would be available to the Forest Service, without further appropriation, to acquire other lands within the Francis Marion National Forest. CBO estimates that implementing the legislation would increase offsetting receipts and associated direct spending by less than \$50,000 in 2011.
