

CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE COST ESTIMATE

H.R. 608 Smithsonian Institution Facilities Authorization Act of 2009

As ordered reported by the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure on February 12, 2009

H.R. 608 would authorize the appropriation of \$41 million for laboratory and support space at the Smithsonian Environmental Research Center in Edgewater, Maryland; \$14 million for laboratory space at the Smithsonian tropical research institute in Gamboa, Panama; and \$12 million for a greenhouse facility in Suitland, Maryland. Assuming appropriation of the authorized amounts, CBO estimates that implementing H.R. 608 would cost \$67 million over the 2009-2013 period, as shown in the following table. Enacting the bill would not affect direct spending or receipts.
