

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 847
OFFERED BY MR. SMITH (TX)

Strike each of sections 201, 202, and 203 and insert the following (and make such technical and conforming changes as may be appropriate):

1 **SEC. 201. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR CLAIMS UNDER**
2 **SEPTEMBER 11TH VICTIM COMPENSATION**
3 **FUND OF 2001.**

4 Section 405(a)(3) of the Air Transportation Safety
5 and System Stabilization Act (49 U.S.C. 10101 note) is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 “(3) LIMITATION.—

8 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided by
9 subparagraph (B), no claim may be filed under
10 paragraph (1) after the date that is 2 years
11 after the date on which regulations are promul-
12 gated under the first sentence of section 407.

13 “(B) EXCEPTION.—A claim may be filed
14 under paragraph (1) by an individual (or by a
15 personal representative on behalf of a deceased
16 individual) during the 5-year period beginning
17 on the date of the enactment of the James

1 Zadroga 9/11 Health and Compensation Act of
2 2010.

3 “(C) LIMITATION.—The total payment of
4 amounts for compensation under this title, with
5 respect to claims filed after the date of the en-
6 actment of the James Zadroga 9/11 Health and
7 Compensation Act of 2010 shall not exceed
8 \$5,500,000,000.”.

9 **SEC. 202. UPDATED REGULATIONS.**

10 Section 407 of such Act is amended by adding at the
11 end the following new sentence:

12 “Not later than 90 days after the date of the enactment
13 of the James Zadroga 9/11 Health and Compensation Act
14 of 2010, the Special Master shall update such regula-
15 tions.”.

 Strike section 205 and redesignate section 204 as
 section 203 (and make such technical and conforming
 changes as may be appropriate).
