The following requests are Idaho-related projects supported and sponsored by Senators Crapo and Risch:

Item Name: American with Disabilities Act Bus Stop Improvements

Amount Requested: \$800,000

Recipient: Valley Regional Transit/COMPASS **Location of work:** Ada and Canyon Counties, Idaho

Public Interest: To provide accessibility for public transportation services in compliance with the

Americans with Disabilities Act

Project Description: The improvements to the bus stops include installation of wheelchair access points, modifications to curbs and ramps, shelter improvements, and signage and audible signal crossings.

Item Name: College of Southern Idaho Student Safety Initiative

Amount Requested: \$500,000
Recipient: College of Southern Idaho
Location of work: Twin Falls, Idaho

Public Interest: To provide a safe traffic pattern for pedestrians

Project Description: The project will continue traffic flow improvements and a bypass to mitigate cross-

campus traffic flow.

Item Name: Eastern Idaho Community Action Partnership Program Consolidation Initiative

Amount Requested: \$1,000,000

Recipient: Eastern Idaho Community Action Partnership

Location of work: Idaho Falls, Idaho

Public Interest: To consolidate service facilities for low-income clients in one building

Project Description: The project will remodel a building used by the Partnership in order to consolidate services for low-income Idahoans operating in separate facilities. The renovations will meet Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design Silver certification requirements.

right-of-way along the 25-mile stretch of forest highway between Banks and Lowman.

Public Interest: To reduce congestion on a major commuter route in Ada County

Project Description: The project will support installation of Intelligent Transportation System devices, including signal upgrades, Traffic Management Center improvements, and dynamic messaging signs to

alert commuters to traffic incidents.

Item Name: North Idaho Remote Communications Outlet

Project Description: This project will plan and construct a two-lane railroad overpass with bike and pedestrian paths across a railroad track that currently separates the Center from Idaho National

Laboratory facilities.

Public Interest: To provide recreation trails to the community

Project Description: The project will provide pedestrian and wheelchair access along the Snake River in

Rexburg.

Public Interest: To develop a regional park from donated land

Project Description: The project will construct nature trails, a boat launch, wildlife habitat, parking, and

restrooms at Ryder Park.

Item Name: Treasure Valley High Capacity Alternative Analysis

Amount Requested: \$3,130,000

Recipient: Community Planning Association of Southwest Idaho

Location of work: Ada and Canyon Counties, Idaho

Public Interest: To develop alternative transportation options for reducing congestion, easing freight

movement, and increasing economic vitality in the region

Project Description: The project will evaluate alternative transportation options along the I-84 corridor

in Ada and Canyon Counties, including the possible use of the Boise Cut-off rail corridor.

Item Name: Treasure Valley Transit Facilities

Amount Requested: \$1,840,000 Recipient: Valley Regional Transit

Location of work: Ada and Canyon Counties, Idaho

Public Interest: To improve transit services

Project Description: The project will identify and acquire site locations and prepare required environmental analysis for up to four transfer centers and and maintenance facilities with the goal of

providing up to 100 new park-and-ride parking spaces at up to four locations.
