### PATERSON SCHOOLS

- **\$59.4 million** to prevent teacher cuts and enhance services
- **\$12.7 million** for Title I to help all children meet challenging state academic standards
- **\$8.9 million** in IDEA funding to support children with disabilities



### PATERSON POLICE

- **\$3.7 million** of direct funding to the Paterson Police Department to keep 25 officers on the beat
- **\$4.5 million** towards a new station for Paterson Fire Department Engine Company No. 7

### PATERSON ROADS

- **\$9.8 million** for roadway resurfacing and improvements throughout Paterson

### PATERSON FIRE DEPARTMENT

- **\$4.5 million** towards a new station for Paterson Fire Department Engine Company No. 7

### PATERSON SCHOOLS

- **\$2.6 million** for local governments to improve energy efficiency and create new green-collar jobs
- **\$7.14 million** for job training
- **\$3 million** to hire staff and engage in case management for homelessness prevention, short term rental assistance, and job training

### PATERSON GREEN ENERGY

- Over **\$157.55 million** for local school districts to keep teachers in their jobs
- **\$507.1 million** in grants to help students and their families pay for secondary education

### PATERSON ENVIRONMENT

- **\$51 billion** in total tax cuts for Small Businesses, including:
  - **\$13 billion** in tax credits for renewable energy production
  - **\$15 billion** to allow businesses to purchase capital equipment and claim an immediate credit

### PATERSON TRANSPORTATION

- **\$237 billion** in tax cuts nationally for individuals, including:
  - **\$15 billion** to expand the child tax credit
  - **\$14 billion** to expand the college credit
  - **\$6.6 billion** in Homebuyer credit

### PATERSON INFRASTRUCTURE

- **\$1.5 billion** for a new commuter rail tunnel to reduce daily traffic congestion
- **\$80 million** for bridge construction, resurfacing, and other projects that will help lower commute times and ensure the stability of our roads

### PATERSON SENIORS

- Over 98,000 seniors and disabled veterans in the 8th Congressional District received a **\$250 additional** one-time payment to help in these difficult economic times
- Providing **\$100 million** for critical senior nutrition programs

### CLIFTON SCHOOLS

- **\$329,000** for repairs and curb improvements to streets in Clifton
- **\$42,500** to preserve and create jobs and enhance mentoring programs at local Boys & Girls Clubs.

### CLIFTON GREEN ENERGY

- **\$2.8 million** for infrastructure improvements to the Grove Street bridge over Route 46

### CLIFTON TRANSPORTATION

- **\$1.5 million** to modernize units and update energy efficiency

### CLIFTON INFRASTRUCTURE

- **\$1.6 million** to the Passaic Police Department for the purchase of equipment and the hiring and retention of career officers

### CLIFTON SENIORS

- **\$147.7 billion** for health care across the country, including:
  - **\$86.6 billion** to support Medicaid
  - **\$19 billion** for health information technology to improve quality, reduce medical errors, and lower health care costs

### PASSAIC SCHOOLS

- **\$3.2 million** to prevent teacher cuts and enhance services
- **\$1.6 million** for Title I to help all children meet challenging state academic standards
- **\$3.1 million** in IDEA funding to support children with disabilities

### PASSAIC GREEN ENERGY

- **\$43 million** for New Jersey to ensure the quality of drinking water
- **\$14.4 million** to assist New Jersey's state and local governments in increasing their energy efficiency
