
CBO on Finance Health Plan Bending Long-Term Cost Curve

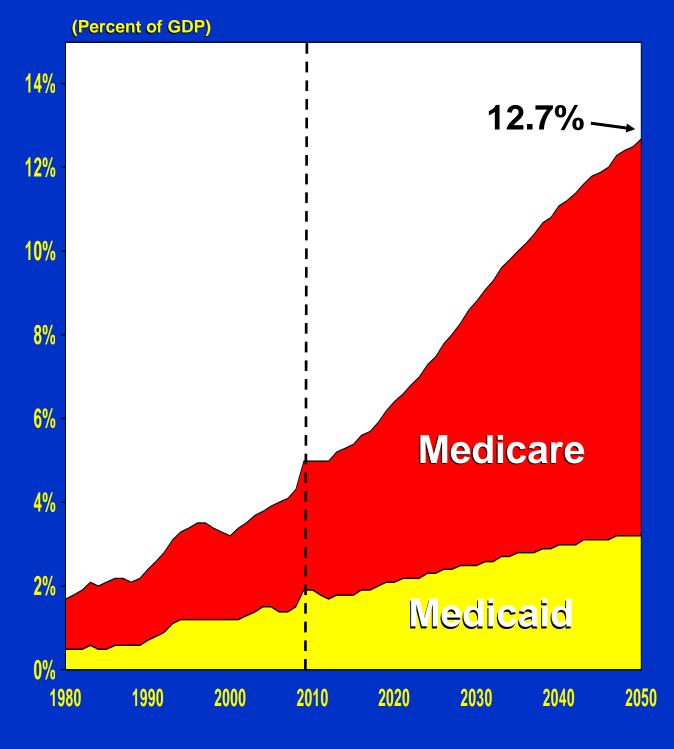
