# **Seniors**

If you have problems with Social Security or Medicare, retirement and survivor benefits, or disability and Supplemental Social Security Income (SSI), my staff can help you.

## **Business**

I offer seminars on taxes and loan opportunities for small business owners. My staff can provide information regarding loans from the Small Business Administration and opportunities to sell goods and services to the U.S. Government. I can also help you obtain assistance from federal agencies that promote U.S. exports.

### **U.S. Flags and Commendations**



My office can provide you a U.S. flag, at cost, which will be flown over the U.S. Capitol. Each flag comes with a certificate of

authenticity and the date it was flown. We also accept requests for written commendations from my office or the White House in recognition of special occasions and honors. In addition, photographs of the President, Vice President, and First Lady are available upon request.
