AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3534 OFFERED BY MS. PINGREE OF MAINE

At the end of title I add the following:

İ	SEC OFFICE OF OFFSHORE RENEWABLE ENERGY.
2	(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established within
3	the Office of the Secretary of the Interior an Office of
4	Offshore Renewable Energy to be headed by a Director
5	of Offshore Renewable Energy.
6	(b) DUTIES.—The Director shall—
7	(1) carry out all functions, powers, and duties
8	vested in the Secretary relating to ocean renewable
9	energy resource management, including planning,
10	leasing, licensing, and fee and royalty collection for
11	such ocean renewable energy resource facilities;
12	(2) develop and administer an efficient leasing
13	and licensing process for offshore renewable energy
4	resource facilities to promote the environmentally
5	sustainable development of such resources.
6	(c) FUNCTIONS.—The Director—
7	(1) shall promulgate and implement regulations
8	pursuant to this Act;

Ţ	(2) shall recommend to the Secretary actions
2	that would expedite permitting of offshore renewable
3	energy resource development while ensuring compli-
4	ance with all environmental laws and regulations;
5	and
6	(3) may study barriers to the development of
7	emerging renewable energy resource technologies on
8	the Outer Continental Shelf and make recommenda-
9	tions on overcoming such barriers.
10	(d) FINDING REGARDING TRANSFER OF DUTIES OF
11	OFFICE.—Five years after the date of enactment of this
12	Act, the Secretary shall make a finding as to whether off-
13	shore renewable technologies and projects have progressed
14	sufficiently that the duties of the Office should be trans-
15	ferred out of the Secretary's office and into a separate
16	entity within the Department of the Interior.
