Page 74, after line 16, insert the following:

1	SEC. 195. The Secretary of Transportation shall con-
2	duct a study, in consultation with the Secretary of Energy,
3	regarding how the United States Government can best as-
4	sist the States and metropolitan planning organizations in
5	implementing "green highway" programs to promote use
6	of alternative fuel vehicles, primarily through development
7	of electric charging and alternative fuels stations, in inter-
8	state highway corridors. This study shall examine current
9	Federal grant programs under the Department of Trans-
10	portation, the Department of Energy, and other agencies
11	that could benefit such green highways, whether additional
12	grant programs are needed to address this need, how the
13	Department of Transportation and the Department of En-
14	ergy can improve their interagency coordination regarding
15	planning and deployment of alternative fuel infrastruc-
16	ture, the eligibility of State departments of transportation
17	and metropolitan planning organizations for State Energy
18	Program funding from the Department of Energy, and
19	how Federal agencies could otherwise assist States and

- 2 green highway programs. This study should also identify
- 3 current interstate highway corridors in which such green
- 4 highway practices are currently in use or programs are
- 5 already underway and in which Federal investment could

- 8 members of the House and Senate Appropriations Com-
- 9 mittees, the House Committee on Transportation and In-
- 10 frastructure, and the Senate Committee on Environment
- 11 and Public Works by June 30, 2011.
