Enclosed is an Attorney General delegation of authority to his Chief of Staff and to the White House Liaison to take final action on personnel actions now proposed to be reserved to the Attorney General by regulation. OLC indicates that permitting the Attorney General's delegates to approve appointments (or removals) of constitutionally "inferior officers," which may include some appointed offices the Attorney General wants to reserve to himself such as certain DAAGs, might be inconsistent with this Clause. OLC has not definitively ruled on the question. OLC does recommend, however, that the delegates exercising the authority of this delegation submit appointments to the Attorney General (individually or in groups) and that each appointment be made in the Attorney General's name.²

¹The Excepting Clause of the Constitution provides that "Congress may by law vest the appointment of such inferior Officers, as they think proper, in the President alone, in the Courts of Law, or in the Heads of Department." U.S. Const. art. II, §2, cl.2.
