Senate Budget Committee Releases Updated Tally of Hurricane-Related Spending

Following the enactment of the 2007 emergency supplemental appropriations bill, which included \$6.527 billion in additional hurricane recovery spending on Hurricanes Katrina and Rita of 2005, the Senate Budget Committee today issued an updated tally of congressional legislation related to the 2005 hurricanes. Enacted hurricane-related relief is now more than \$132 billion.



The above chart includes revised figures for historical disaster funding. Past charts have included the total amount appropriated in each supplemental appropriation bill in response to each disaster, which included amounts not provided for disaster relief. Detailed work by CRS (<u>http://www.congress.gov/erp/rl/html/RL33226.html</u>) breaks out the portion of each supplemental appropriation that went specifically for disaster relief efforts. The revised chart below reflects this refinement of the data.
