

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2701, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. ROGERS OF MICHIGAN**

At the end of subtitle A of title V, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 505. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS TO TRANSFER**  
2 **DETAINEES FROM GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA,**  
3 **FOR CRIMINAL PROSECUTION IN THE**  
4 **UNITED STATES.**

5       (a) PROHIBITION.—None of the funds authorized to  
6 be appropriated by this Act may be used to transfer an  
7 unprivileged enemy belligerent from Naval Station, Guan-  
8 tanamo Bay, Cuba, to the United States for the purpose  
9 of a criminal prosecution in a United States District Court  
10 or the court of a State, territory, or possession of the  
11 United States or the District of Columbia.

12       (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

13               (1) UNITED STATES.—The term “United  
14 States” means the several States, the District of Co-  
15 lumbia, Puerto Rico, the Northern Mariana Islands,  
16 the Virgin Islands, Guam, American Samoa, and  
17 any other territory or possession of the United  
18 States.

1           (2) UNPRIVILEGED ENEMY BELLIGERENT.—

2       The term “unprivileged enemy belligerent” has the  
3       meaning given the term in section 948a of title 10,  
4       United States Code.
