**DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO DOUGLASS CAMPUS:**

**From the New Jersey Turnpike (north or south):**

Turn off at Exit 9, bear right after the tollbooths and follow signs for "Route 18 North – New Brunswick." Stay to the left to continue on Route 18 North. Proceed along Route 18 North.

\*Follow Commercial Avenue through the first traffic light. At the second traffic light make a left onto George Street. Continue on George Street to the first traffic light. The Douglass Campus Center will be on the right at the corner of George Street and Nichol Avenue. Parking is available by making a right at that light onto Nichol Avenue and then the first left onto Lipman Drive and a left into the parking lot.

**From Garden State Parkway South:** Take Exit 129 to NJ Turnpike South to Exit 9. Take the exit on the left marked "Commercial Avenue". \*Follow New Jersey Turnpike directions from this point.

**From Garden State Parkway North:** Take Exit 105 to Route 18 North. Take the exit on the left marked "Commercial Avenue". \*Follow NJ Turnpike directions from this point.

**From Route 1:** Turn off Route 1 at exit marked "Route 18 North – New Brunswick." \*Follow NJ Turnpike directions from this point.

**From Route 287:** Turn off at Exit 9 "River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park." Proceed East on River Road toward Highland Park. Make a right onto Route 18 South (exit after the traffic light at Landing Lane). Cross the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge. Continue on Route 18 South. Make a right onto Commercial Avenue. \*Follow NJ Turnpike directions from this point.

**PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:**

**Douglass College is accessible by public transportation.**

**New Jersey Transit's Northeast Corridor Line** provides New Brunswick with both local and express service between New York and Newark's Penn Stations and Trenton, New Jersey. (For information, call 800-772-2222).

**SEPTA (Southeastern Pennsylvania Transit Authority)** provides service at Trenton to and from Philadelphia. (For information, call 215-580-7800).

**Amtrak** provides limited direct service to New Brunswick; however, connections can easily be made via New Jersey Transit trains to principal Amtrak stations at MetroPark, New York and Trenton. (For information, call 1-800-USA-RAIL).

For information on **New Jersey Transit Bus Routes**, call 973-762-5100. For information on **Suburban Transit Bus Routes**, call 800-222-0492.

**Newark Airport** is also within a 1-hour drive of the campus.

The **New Brunswick Train Station** is located at the corner of Albany Street and Easton Avenue across from the Rutgers Bookstore. Taxi service is available from the train station. Rutgers University Campus Bus Route "F" or "EE" will provide direct service from the train station to Douglass Campus. The Rutgers University Campus Bus Stop is located at the corner of Somerset St. and George St.

**Parking for Public**

Parking is available in the parking deck located directly behind the Douglass College Center. Proceed to rear entrance to Douglass College Center. Information center attendant will direct you to Trayer Hall.
