My staff and I stand ready to assist you with concerns and challenges you may have related to federal agencies and issues.

MEDICARE AND SOCIAL SECURITY ASSISTANCE

We can assist you in determining eligibility for coverage of health care services and in resolving reimbursement issues. We can provide information about various Social Security programs,



including retirement and survivor benefits, disability, and Supplemental Security Income (SSI). We can also help you handle problems with the Social Security Administration.

MILITARY ACADEMY APPOINTMENTS

Each year, I recommend a select number of district high school graduates for admission to the U.S. military academies: Army, Navy, Air Force, and Merchant Marine. Nominations are made on a non-political, competitive basis. Applicants must reside in the 13th Congressional District. If you are interested in applying, contact us early in your junior year.

VETERANS ASSISTANCE

Veterans can obtain information on health care services and resources. We can also help you determine your eligibility at VA hospitals and provide assistance with disability, retirement and survivor benefits, and interment in a national cemetery.

FLAG REQUESTS

Many Americans show their patriotism for our country by flying the American Flag. These flags are also used to commemorate the valor of our nation's veterans on Veterans Day and Memorial Day or to celebrate Independence Day. Whatever the occasion, my office can help you secure flags that have actually been flown over the U.S. Capitol and others that have not.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS


My office can provide you with passport applications. If you have an emergency situation and give us at least two weeks notice, we may be able to assist you with expediting your application.

INTERNSHIPS

Internships provide students in my district with opportunities to see how government works, to develop their leadership and communication skills, and to gain experience that will help them handle future challenges. Interested high school, college students, and recent college graduates can apply by contacting my office.
