SENATE DPC HEALTH INSURANCE REFORM VIDEO SERIES ADDS Q&A ON PUBLIC OPTION

(WASHINGTON, D.C.) --- New questions and answers about the public option have been added to the "Citizens Forum" video series posted by the Senate Democratic Policy Committee (DPC) at its website, link included here. Senators Sherrod Brown (D-OH), Kay Hagen (D-NC), and Bernie Sanders (I-VT) answer questions from citizens on the topic in the latest postings. The new video questions come from residents of California, Michigan, and Kentucky.

The "Citizens Forum" features average Americans asking questions about issues in the health insurance reform debate. Questions are answered by Democratic members of the U.S. Senate. The series is updated periodically with new questions from citizens and answers from Senators.
