Summary of H.R. 174 Establishment of National Cemetery in the Southern Colorado Region

Title: To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a national cemetery for veterans in the southern Colorado region.

Mr. Salazar introduced H.R. 174 on January 6, 2009.

H.R. 174 would:

- 1. Establish a National Cemetery in Southern Colorado Region
- 2. Require the Secretary to establish a national cemetery in El Paso County, Colorado.
- 3. Require the Secretary to consult with state and local officials in site selection.
- 4. Require the Secretary to consult with government officials in site selection.
- 5. Authorize the Secretary to accept a gift of an appropriate parcel of real property to use as cemetery.
- 6. Require the Secretary to submit to Congress a report on the establishment of the cemetery.
- 7. Require the Secretary to add the cemetery to the current list of priority projects, but does not allow this cemetery to take priority over any of the current priority projects.
