

AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MR. BRADY OF TEXAS

[HR 3200]

At the end of subtitle B of title II of division A (relating to the public health insurance option), add the following:

1 SEC. \_\_\_\_ . REPEAL OF PUBLIC PLAN IF PUBLIC PLAN RE-  
2 SULTS IN WORSE CANCER SURVIVAL RATES.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—If the Secretary of Health and  
4 Human Services determines, based on the data collected  
5 under subsection (b), that national 5-year cancer survival  
6 rates for breast, prostate, and lung cancer for enrollees  
7 in the public health insurance option are worse than the  
8 corresponding average survival rates for enrollees in other  
9 health benefits plans (after adjusting for risk) offered  
10 through the Health Insurance Exchange, then the public  
11 health insurance option shall cease to operate and any en-  
12 rollees in such option as of such cessation shall be per-  
13 mitted to enroll (in such manner as the Health Choices  
14 Commissioner may provide) in any other health benefits  
15 plan offered through the Health Insurance Exchange.

16 (b) STUDY.—The Comptroller General shall collect  
17 data, <sup>beginning for 2013,</sup> on an annual basis, on the 5-year cancer survival

1 rates for breast, prostate, and lung cancer for enrollees  
2 in the public health insurance option and for enrollees in  
3 other Exchange-participating health benefits plans.

4 (c) REPORTS; MARKETING MATERIAL.—

5 (1) REPORTS.—The Comptroller General shall, <sup>beginning for 2013,</sup>  
6 annually make a written report to Congress pre-  
7 senting the data collected under subsection (b) for  
8 the preceding calendar year.

9 (2) MARKETING MATERIAL.—Data related to  
10 the cancer survival rates described in subsection (B)  
11 shall be included in marketing materials for all  
12 qualified health benefits plans and must be made  
13 available in an easily accessible manner to the pub-  
14 lic.
