\$48,000 Federal Grant Will Purchase New Firefighting Equipment

US. Representative Rick Boucher announced today that, at his urging, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, through its Rural Development Agency, is providing a federal grant of \$48,000 to the Town of Haysi to purchase new firefighting equipment for the Haysi Volunteer Fire Department.

"This allocation of federal funding will enable the purchase of new equipment for the Haysi Volunteer Fire Department, providing an added measure of safety for its members," Boucher said.

With the benefit of the federal funds, four new self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) units and twenty air canisters, which can be inserted into the SCBA units in the event that oxygen in the original cylinder diminishes, will be purchased. The new air canisters will replace older models that no longer comply with federal safety rules. Additionally, six new sets of turnout gear will be purchased to replace older gear that has become worn due to age. The Department will also purchase one thermal imaging camera to be placed on the Department's
