- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON IMPEDING CERTAIN ACTIVI-
- 4 TIES OF THE SECRETARY OF HOMELAND SE-
- 5 CURITY RELATED TO BORDER SECURITY.
- 6 On public lands of the United States, neither the Sec-
- 7 retary of the Interior nor the Secretary of Agriculture may

- 1 impede, prohibit, or restrict activities of the Secretary of
- 2 Homeland Security to achieve operational control (as de-
- 3 fined in section 2(b) of the Secure Fence Act of 2006 (8

4 U.S.C. 1701 note; Public Law 109–367).
