You may choose a <u>first and second place</u> finalist to be judged against the winners of other schools, within our congressional district, to determine the overall winner. The <u>two entries</u> from your school must be received in my Hot Springs congressional office located at 300 Exchange Street, Suite A, Hot Springs, AR, 71901 no later than Friday, April 23, 2010.

We will then ask art professionals from throughout our congressional district to serve as judges to select first, second, and third place winners from the Fourth Congressional District.

I will cover the cost of framing (if the piece is not already framed), plus shipping to our nation's capitol for the first place winning artwork from the Fourth Congressional District. First place winners from each Congressional District across the nation will be entered in the national competition. Also, first place winners from each District will be awarded two round trip tickets by Southwest Airlines to travel to Washington D.C. to attend the national reception on June 17th and view their artwork in the capitol.

The second and third place winners from the Fourth Congressional District will be honored by having their artwork hung in my district offices.

In addition, first place winners will be eligible to receive a scholarship to Savannah College of Art and Design, should they apply and are accepted.
