Sources of Funding

City Share - \$450,000

Proposed Federal Share - \$2,100,000

The City share of \$450,000 has already been incurred in the planning and design of the project, including installation of a 16-inch water supply well. Federal grant funding is needed if this project is to move forward into the final phase of construction.

Duration of Project

The City already has bid ready documents prepared. The project is anticipated to take approximately one year to complete from the time that federal funding would become available.

Budget Details

Federal funding would be used to purchase several items of equipment including, 125 hp well pump, 125 hp high flow pump, two 15 hp booster pumps, chlorine gas disinfection equipment, 200 kW backup generator, pressure reducing valve assembly, altitude valve assembly, and the related electrical and control equipment. The estimated cost of the equipment is \$500,000 to \$650,000.


Dear Congressman Reichert:
