Congress must also do its part and as we serve together on the Appropriations Subcommittee of jurisdiction, I strongly urge you to schedule hearings on this matter at the earliest opportunity. We need to make right the situation for the aggrieved families and more importantly, we need to ensure something like this never happens again.
