




### **Government Spending**

(Percentage of the Economy [GDP])




#### Government Spending

#### Spending Increase


(84 Percent Increase Non-Defense Discretionary, Billions of Dollars [BA])


#### **Government Deficits**








#### Unemployment Benefits: \$125 Billion and Growing



(Marginal Rate)




#### **National Debt**


# Public Debt: Nearly Half Owned by Foreign Entities

#### Long-Term Spending





#### **Current Policies Unsustainable**


(Debt Held by the Public as Percentage of GDP)
