The service academies seek candidates with extraordinary academic, physical, and leadership skills. Regrettably, even a Congressional nomination does not guarantee admission.

Eligible candidates for a Congressional nomination must be United States citizens, reside in the Georgia's Second Congressional District, and be at least 17 years of age, but not yet past your 23rd birthday, on July 1st of the year admitted. To apply, candidates should download the application materials below, or contact my Thomasville district office at (229) 226-7789 to request an application packet. In order for applications to be reviewed and processed in a timely manner, applications must be submitted to my district office by November 1st of the student's senior year.
