Dear Chairman Inouye and Chairman Leahy:

We are writing today to respectfully request that you include language in the Fiscal Year 2011 State, Foreign Operations and Related Programs Appropriations bill codifying the repeal of the Mexico City Policy—also known as the Global Gag Rule—on family planning providers working overseas.

In short, it is time to permanently repeal the Global Gag Rule because it is the right thing to do. Not only will a permanent repeal reduce the number of abortions around the globe, it will help reduce the spread of sexually transmitted diseases and help prevent unintended or unplanned pregnancies.

Furthermore, permanently repealing the Global Gag Rule will help establish greater certainty and continuity for reproductive health care providers. While we are pleased that President Obama rescinded the Global Gag Rule by Executive Order shortly after taking office, a permanent repeal in law would give reproductive health care providers working in difficult and often underserved regions around the globe the ability to plan for the long-term delivery of contraceptives and health care to the populations they serve.

Thank you for your continued leadership and commitment to universal access to family planning and reproductive health care. We look forward to working with you and your staff in the coming weeks and months to permanently repeal this unjust, hurtful and ineffective policy.
