The House Committee on Energy and Commerce and its Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations are examining the response plans maintained by BP and Transocean before the April 20, 2010, explosion of the Deepwater Horizon drilling rig in the Gulf of Mexico.

We believe you may have documents relevant to the Committee's investigation because we understand that O'Brien's Response Management (O'Brien'sRM) served as a consultant on emergency response issues to both BP and Transocean. To assist the Committee with its investigation, we ask that you provide the following documents:

- 1. All emergency response plans, including drafts, prepared by O'Brien'sRM for BP or Transocean related to the Transocean Marianas or Deepwater Horizon rigs or the Macondo well site;
- 2. All documents, including e-mails, related to the emergency response needs or capabilities of the Transocean Marianas or the Deepwater Horizon rigs or emergency response at the Macondo well site;
- 3. All documents, including e-mails, provided to O'Brien's RM by BP or Transocean related to the Transocean Marianas or the Deepwater Horizon rigs or the Macondo well site;
- 4. All documents relating to a failure to control an oil well on the seabed.
