Dear Mr. Newman:

The Committee on Energy and Commerce and its Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations are investigating the April 20, 2010, explosion at the Deepwater Horizon oil drilling rig. The Committee's investigation, recent media accounts, and statements by workers present on the rig have raised questions about safety practices on the Deepwater Horizon and the condition of equipment on the rig. Yesterday, *The New York Times* reported on a survey that found that rig workers feared reprisals for expressing safety concerns and documentation of the poor condition of numerous pieces of rig equipment. Today, Michael Williams testified before the Marine Board of Investigation that alarm systems on the rig had been put in "inhibited" mode to prevent false alarms.

To assist the Committee in investigating these developments, we request that you provide the following documents to the Committee for the period from January 1, 2005, to the present:

- 1. All documents related to safety on the rig, including any surveys of rig workers' attitudes about safety on the rig and any safety concerns or complaints expressed by any contracting party, rig worker, third party contractor, or rig inspector.
- 2. All documents related to the maintenance, functionality, repair, or replacement of equipment on the rig.

Please produce the requested documents to the Committee by July 30, 2010. An attachment to this letter provides additional information on how to respond to the Committee's request.
