

Project Name: Southern Cumberland Plateau

Request Amount: \$100,000

Explanation of the request: Southern Cumberland Plateau is in Franklin, Grundy, Marion, and Sequatchie Counties. Water is a major limiting factor for these counties. The elevation of the Plateau does not allow for water to flow to the river, and the only major source is rain water. The drought of 2007 -2008 highlighted the need for water sources for this region. The Corps received a request from the Sewanee Utility District and the Cagle-Fredonia Utility District to undertake a comprehensive study for the combined watershed basins in the Southern Cumberland Plateau in Franklin, Grundy, Marion, and Sequatchie Counties.
