AN ACT

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide secret service protection to former Vice Presidents, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be referred to as the “Former Vice
3 President Protection Act of 2008”.

4 **SEC. 2. SECRET SERVICE PROTECTION FOR FORMER VICE**
5 **PRESIDENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES.**

6 Section 3056(a) of title 18, United States Code, is
7 amended—

8 (1) by inserting immediately after paragraph
9 (7) the following:

10 “(8) Former Vice Presidents, their spouses, and
11 their children who are under 16 years of age, for a
12 period of not more than six months after the date
13 the former Vice President leaves office. The Sec-
14 retary of Homeland Security shall have the authority
15 to direct the Secret Service to provide temporary
16 protection for any of these individuals at any time
17 thereafter if the Secretary of Homeland Security or
18 designee determines that information or conditions
19 warrant such protection.”; and

20 (2) in the sentence immediately preceding sub-
21 section (b) of section 3056, by striking “(7)” and in-
22 serting “(8)”.

1 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with
3 respect to any Vice President holding office on or after
4 the date of enactment of the Act.
