RESOLUTION

Waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

1 *Resolved*, That the requirement of clause 6(a) of rule
2 XIII for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the
3 Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to
4 the House is waived with respect to any resolution re-
5 ported on or before the legislative day of December 19,
6 2007, providing for consideration or disposition of any of
7 the following measures:

1 (1) A bill relating to the Children’s Health In-
2 surance Program, or an amendment thereto.

3 (2) A bill relating to Medicare, or an amend-
4 ment thereto.

5 (3) A bill relating to the alternative minimum
6 tax, or an amendment thereto.

7 (4) A joint resolution making further con-
8 tinuing appropriations for the fiscal year 2008, or
9 an amendment thereto.

10 (5) The bill (H.R. 2764) making appropriations
11 for the Department of State, foreign operations, and
12 related programs for the fiscal year ending Sep-
13 tember 30, 2008, and for other purposes, or an
14 amendment thereto.
