## AN ACT

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to extend the pilot program for alternative water source projects.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Healthy Communities
- 3 Water Supply Act of 2007".
- 4 SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM FOR ALTERNATIVE WATER
- 5 SOURCE PROJECTS.
- 6 (a) SELECTION OF PROJECTS.—Section 220(d)(2) of
- 7 the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.
- 8 1300(d)(2)) is amended by inserting before the period at
- 9 the end the following: "or whether the project is located
- 10 in an area which is served by a public water system serving
- 11 10,000 individuals or fewer".
- 12 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
- 13 220(j) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33
- 14 U.S.C. 1300(j)) is amended by striking "\$75,000,000 for
- 15 fiscal years 2002 through 2004" and inserting
- 16 "\$125,000,000".
- 17 SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON THE USE OF FUNDS.
- None of the funds authorized by this Act, including
- 19 the amendments made by this Act, may be used—
- 20 (1) to lobby or retain a lobbyist for the purpose
- of influencing a Federal, State, or local govern-
- 22 mental entity or officer; or

- 1 (2) to pay for expenses related to the member-
- 2 ship of any individual or entity in an organization or
- 3 association.
