Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1 *Resolved*, That it shall be in order at any time on
2 the legislative day of Sunday, December 18, 2005, for the
3 Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the
4 rules relating to the following measures:

5 (1) The bill (H.R. 1185) to reform the Federal
6 deposit insurance system, and for other purposes.

7 (2) A bill to reauthorize the Temporary Assist-
8 ance for Needy Families block grant program
9 through March 31, 2006, and for other purposes.

1 (3) The resolution (H. Res. 545) expressing the
2 sense of the House of Representatives on the arrest
3 of Sanjar Umarov in Uzbekistan.

4 (4) The concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res.
5 284) expressing the sense of Congress with respect
6 to the 2005 presidential and parliamentary elections
7 in Egypt.

8 (5) The bill (H.R. 4501) to amend the Passport
9 Act of June 4, 1920, to authorize the Secretary of
10 State to establish and collect a surcharge to cover
11 the costs of meeting the increased demand for pass-
12 ports as a result of actions taken to comply with sec-
13 tion 7209(b) of the Intelligence Reform and Ter-
14 rorism Prevention Act of 2004.

15 (6) The bill (S. 1988) to authorize the transfer
16 of items in the War Reserves Stockpile for Allies,
17 Korea.

18 (7) The bill (H.R. 2329) to permit eligibility in
19 certain circumstances for an officer or employee of
20 a foreign government to receive a reward under the
21 Department of State Rewards Program.

22 (8) A resolution honoring Helen Sewell on the
23 occasion of her retirement from the House of Rep-
24 resentatives and expressing the gratitude of the
25 House for her many years of service.
