3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Intelligence Authoriza-
- 5 tion Act for Fiscal Year 2006".

TITLE I—INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES

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3 SEC. 101. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

Funds are hereby authorized to be appropriated for
fiscal year 2006 for the conduct of the intelligence and
intelligence-related activities of the following elements of
the United States Government:

- 8 (1) The Office of the Director of National Intel-9 ligence.
- 10 (2) The Central Intelligence Agency.
- 11 (3) The Department of Defense.
- 12 (4) The Defense Intelligence Agency.
- 13 (5) The National Security Agency.
- 14 (6) The Department of the Army, the Depart-15 ment of the Navy, and the Department of the Air
- 16 Force.

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- 17 (7) The Department of State.
- 18 (8) The Department of the Treasury.
- 19 (9) The Department of Energy.
- 20 (10) The Department of Justice.
- 21 (11) The Federal Bureau of Investigation.
- 22 (12) The National Reconnaissance Office.
- 23 (13) The National Geospatial-Intelligence Agen-
- 24 cy.
- 25 (14) The Coast Guard.

1 (15) The Department of Homeland Security.

2 SEC. 102. CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AUTHORIZATIONS.

3 (a) Specifications of Amounts and Personnel 4 CEILINGS.—The amounts authorized to be appropriated 5 under section 101, and the authorized personnel ceilings as of September 30, 2006, for the conduct of the intel-6 7 ligence and intelligence-related activities of the elements 8 listed in such section, are those specified in the classified 9 Schedule of Authorizations prepared to accompany the bill 10 H.R. of the One Hundred Ninth Congress.

(b) AVAILABILITY OF CLASSIFIED SCHEDULE OF AUTHORIZATIONS.—The Schedule of Authorizations shall be
made available to the Committees on Appropriations of
the Senate and House of Representatives and to the President. The President shall provide for suitable distribution
of the Schedule, or of appropriate portions of the Schedule, within the executive branch.

18 SEC. 103. PERSONNEL CEILING ADJUSTMENTS.

(a) AUTHORITY FOR ADJUSTMENTS.—With the approval of the Director of the Office of Management and
Budget, the Director of National Intelligence may authorize employment of civilian personnel in excess of the number authorized for fiscal year 2006 under section 102
when the Director of National Intelligence determines that

such action is necessary to the performance of important
 intelligence functions.

3 (b) NOTICE TO INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEES.—The
4 Director of National Intelligence shall notify promptly the
5 Select Committee on Intelligence of the Senate and the
6 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the House
7 of Representatives whenever the Director exercises the au8 thority granted by this section.

9 SEC. 104. INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT AC-10 COUNT.

11 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is 12 authorized to be appropriated for the Intelligence Commu-13 nity Management Account of the Director of National Intelligence for fiscal year 2006 the sum of \$ 14 15 Within such amount, funds identified in the classified Schedule of Authorizations referred to in section 102(a)16 for advanced research and development shall remain avail-17 able until September 30, 2007. 18

(b) AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL LEVELS.—The ele20 ments within the Intelligence Community Management
21 Account of the Director of National Intelligence are au22 thorized _____ full-time personnel as of September 30,
23 2006. Personnel serving in such elements may be perma24 nent employees of the Intelligence Community Manage-

ment Account or personnel detailed from other elements
 of the United States Government.

3 (c) Classified Authorizations.—

4 (1) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—In 5 addition to amounts authorized to be appropriated 6 for the Intelligence Community Management Ac-7 count by subsection (a), there are also authorized to 8 be appropriated for the Intelligence Community 9 Management Account for fiscal year 2006 such addi-10 tional amounts as are specified in the classified 11 Schedule of Authorizations referred to in section 12 102(a). Such additional amounts for advanced re-13 search and development shall remain available until 14 September 30, 2007.

(2) AUTHORIZATION OF PERSONNEL.—In addition to the personnel authorized by subsection (b)
for elements of the Intelligence Community Management Account as of September 30, 2006, there are
also authorized such additional personnel for such
elements as of that date as are specified in the classified Schedule of Authorizations.

(d) REIMBURSEMENT.—Except as provided in section
113 of the National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C.
404h), during fiscal year 2006 any officer or employee of
the United States or a member of the Armed Forces who

is detailed to the staff of the Intelligence Community Man-1 2 agement Account from another element of the United States Government shall be detailed on a reimbursable 3 4 basis, except that any such officer, employee, or member 5 may be detailed on a nonreimbursable basis for a period of less than one year for the performance of temporary 6 7 functions as required by the Director of National Intel-8 ligence.

9 TITLE II—CENTRAL INTEL10 LIGENCE AGENCY RETIRE11 MENT AND DISABILITY SYS12 TEM

13 SEC. 201. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

There is authorized to be appropriated for the Central Intelligence Agency Retirement and Disability Fund
for fiscal year 2006 the sum of \$_____.

17 **TITLE III—GENERAL** 18 **PROVISIONS**

19 SEC. 301. INCREASE IN EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION AND

BENEFITS AUTHORIZED BY LAW.

Appropriations authorized by this Act for salary, pay, retirement, and other benefits for Federal employees may be increased by such additional or supplemental amounts as may be necessary for increases in such compensation or benefits authorized by law.

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1SEC. 302. RESTRICTION ON CONDUCT OF INTELLIGENCE2ACTIVITIES.

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3 The authorization of appropriations by this Act shall
4 not be deemed to constitute authority for the conduct of
5 any intelligence activity which is not otherwise authorized
6 by the Constitution or the laws of the United States.
