## A BILL

To extend for 6 months the period for which chapter 12 of title 11 of the United States Code is reenacted.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SIX-MONTH EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR WHICH**

4 **CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 11, UNITED STATES**

5 **CODE IS REENACTED.**

6 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 149 of title I of division  
7 C of Public Law 105–277 (11 U.S.C. 1201 note) is  
8 amended—

9 (1) by striking “January 1, 2004” each place  
10 it appears and inserting “July 1, 2004”; and

1 (2) in subsection (a)—

2 (A) by striking “June 30, 2003” and in-  
3 serting “December 31, 2003”; and

4 (B) by striking “July 1, 2003” and insert-  
5 ing “January 1, 2004”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
7 subsection (a) shall take effect on January 1, 2004.
