Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SIX-MONTH EXTENSION OF PERIOD FOR WHICH

CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE 11, UNITED STATES

CODE IS REENACTED.

(a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 149 of title I of division

C of Public Law 105–277 (11 U.S.C. 1201 note) is

amended—

(1) by striking "January 1, 2004" each place

it appears and inserting "July 1, 2004"; and

1	(2) in subsection (a)—
2	(A) by striking "June 30, 2003" and in-
3	serting "December 31, 2003"; and
4	(B) by striking "July 1, 2003" and insert-
5	ing "January 1, 2004".
6	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
7	subsection (a) shall take effect on January 1, 2004.
