AN ACT

To reduce the incidence of child abuse and neglect, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Child Abuse Preven-
- 3 tion and Enforcement Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. GRANT PROGRAM.
- 5 Section 102(b) of the Crime Identification Tech-
- 6 nology Act of 1998 (42 U.S.C. 14601(b)) is amended by
- 7 striking "and" at the end of paragraph (15), by striking
- 8 the period at the end of paragraph (16) and inserting ";
- 9 and", and by adding after paragraph (16) the following:
- "(17) the capability of the criminal justice sys-
- tem to deliver timely, accurate, and complete crimi-
- nal history record information to child welfare agen-
- cies, organizations, and programs that are engaged
- in the assessment of risk and other activities related
- to the protection of children, including protection
- against child sexual abuse, and placement of chil-
- dren in foster care.".
- 18 SEC. 3. USE OF FUNDS UNDER BYRNE GRANT PROGRAM
- 19 FOR CHILD PROTECTION.
- Section 501(b) of title I of the Omnibus Crime Con-
- 21 trol and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3751) is
- 22 amended—
- 23 (1) by striking "and" at the end of paragraph
- (25);
- 25 (2) by striking the period at the end of para-
- graph (26) and adding "; and"; and

2	"(27) enforcing child abuse and neglect laws,
3	including laws protecting against child sexual abuse,
4	and promoting programs designed to prevent child
5	abuse and neglect.".
6	SEC. 4. CONDITIONAL ADJUSTMENT IN SET ASIDE FOR
7	CHILD ABUSE VICTIMS UNDER THE VICTIMS
8	OF CRIME ACT OF 1984.
9	(a) In General.—Section 1402(d)(2) of the Victims
10	of Crime Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10601(d)(2)) is
11	amended—
12	(1) by striking "(2) the next \$10,000,000" and
13	inserting "(2)(A) Except as provided in subpara-
14	graph (B), the next \$10,000,000"; and
15	(2) by adding at the end the following:
16	"(B)(i) For any fiscal year for which the
17	amount deposited in the Fund is greater than the
18	amount deposited in the Fund for fiscal year 1998,
19	the \$10,000,000 referred to in subparagraph (A)
20	plus an amount equal to 50 percent of the increase
21	in the amount from fiscal year 1998 shall be avail-
22	able for grants under section 1404A.
23	"(ii) Amounts available under this subpara-
24	graph for any fiscal year shall not exceed
25	\$20,000,000.".

- 1 (b) Interaction With Any Cap.—Subsection (a)
- 2 shall be implemented so that any increase in funding pro-
- 3 vided thereby shall operate notwithstanding any dollar
- 4 limitation on the availability of the Crime Victims Fund
- 5 established under the Victims of Crime Act of 1984.
