Making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 2001, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That Public Law 106–275, is further amended by striking
- 4 the date specified in section 106(c) and inserting "Decem-

- 1 ber 21, 2000" and by adding the following before the pe-
- 2 riod in section 113: ", and in addition, from within the
- 3 amount provided by section 101, \$217,000,000: Provided,
- 4 That of these funds, \$100,000,000 may be made available
- 5 only pursuant to a certification by the Secretary of State
- 6 that the United Nations has taken no action in calendar
- 7 year 2000 prior to the date of enactment of this Act to
- 8 increase funding for any United Nations program without
- 9 identifying an offsetting decrease elsewhere in the United
- 10 Nations budget and cause the United Nations to exceed
- 11 the budget for the biennium 2000–2001 of
- 12 \$2,535,700,000".
