## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal year 2001, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That Public Law 106–275, is further amended by striking
- 4 the date specified in section 106(c) and inserting

- 1 "December 21, 2000" and by adding the following before
- 2 the period in section 113: ", and in addition, from within
- 3 the amount provided by section 101, \$217,000,000: Pro-
- 4 vided, That of these funds, \$100,000,000 may be made
- 5 available only pursuant to a certification by the Secretary
- 6 of State that the United Nations has taken no action in
- 7 calendar year 2000 prior to the date of enactment of this
- 8 Act to increase funding for any United Nations program
- 9 without identifying an offsetting decrease elsewhere in the
- 10 United Nations budget and cause the United Nations to
- 11 exceed the budget for the biennium 2000–2001 of
- 12 \$2,535,700,000".
