AN ACT

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to reauthorize the Clean Lakes Program.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. GRANTS TO STATES

Section 314(c)(2) of the Federal Water Pollution
Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1324(c)(2)) is amended by striking "\$50,000,000" the first place it appears and all that
follows through "1990" and inserting "\$50,000,000 for
each of fiscal years 2001 through 2005".

7 SEC. 2. DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM.

8 Section 314(d) of the Federal Water Pollution Con9 trol Act (33 U.S.C. 1324(d)) is amended—

10 (1) in paragraph (2) by inserting "Otsego
11 Lake, New York; Oneida Lake, New York; Raystown
12 Lake, Pennsylvania; Swan Lake, Itasca County,
13 Minnesota;" after "Sauk Lake, Minnesota;";

(2) in paragraph (3) by striking "By" and in-14 15 serting "Notwithstanding section 3003 of the Fed-16 eral Reports Elimination and Sunset Act of 1995 17 (31 U.S.C. 1113 note; 109 Stat. 734–736), by"; and 18 (3)(4)(B)(i)bv striking in paragraph 19 "\$15,000,000" and inserting "\$25,000,000".

20 SEC. 3. SENSE OF THE CONGRESS; REQUIREMENT REGARD-

ING NOTICE.

(a) PURCHASE OF AMERICAN-MADE EQUIPMENT
AND PRODUCTS.—In the case of any equipment or products that may be authorized to be purchased with financial
assistance provided under this Act, it is the sense of the
Congress that entities receiving such assistance should, in
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expending the assistance, purchase only American-made
 equipment and products.

3 (b) NOTICE TO RECIPIENTS OF ASSISTANCE.—In 4 providing financial assistance under this Act, the head of 5 each Federal agency shall provide to each recipient of the 6 assistance a notice describing the statement made in sub-7 section (a) by the Congress.

8 (c) NOTICE OF REPORT.—Any entity which receives
9 funds under this Act shall report any expenditures on for10 eign-made items to the Congress within 180 days of ex11 penditure.
