- DON'T GIVE OUT PERSONAL INFORMATION OVER THE PHONE, THROUGH THE MAIL OR ON THE INTERNET UNLESS YOU'VE INITIATED THE CONTACT OR ARE SURE YOU KNOW WHO YOU'RE DEALING WITH.
