

MOTION TO INSTRUCT

Mr. Ryan of Wisconsin moves that the managers on the part of the House at the conference on the disagreeing votes of the two Houses on the House amendment to the concurrent resolution on the budget, S. Con. Res. 13, be instructed, within the scope of the conference, to:

1 (1) Recede to the Senate on reconciliation in-
2 structions by striking title II of the House amend-
3 ment which includes reconciliation instructions for
4 health care reform to the Committees on Energy
5 and Commerce and Ways and Means and a separate
6 instruction to the Committee on Education and
7 Labor.

8 (2) Recede to the Senate on section 316 enti-
9 tled “Point of order on legislation that eliminates
10 the ability of Americans to keep their health plan or
11 their choice of doctor” to provide for a point of
12 order against any legislation that eliminates the abil-
13 ity of Americans to keep their health plan or their
14 choice of doctor.

15 (3) Recede to the Senate on section 202(c) of
16 the Senate resolution, providing that the chairman

1 of the Committee on the Budget of the Senate may
2 not adjust the allocations and aggregates of the con-
3 current resolution for climate change legislation that
4 would decrease greenhouse gas emissions and pro-
5 vide for a cap and trade policy if such legislation is
6 reported from a committee pursuant to section 310
7 of the Congressional Budget Act, and apply such
8 section 202(c) to the House.

9 (4) Recede to the Senate on section 310 of the
10 Senate resolution, setting forth a point of order
11 against legislation that increases revenue above the
12 levels established in the budget resolution.
