**Name of Project:** Support for Certain Civilian Medical Care at Guam Naval Hospital

**Project Description:** The requested provision would authorize the Secretary of the Navy to provide medical services at United States Naval Hospital, Guam, and transportation to that facility, on a nonreimbursable basis, for civilian patients who are citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM), the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI), and the Republic of Palau (RoP) who the U.S. has the responsibility for providing defense to their nations. The authorization would be for services not to exceed \$5,000,000 in costs in fiscal year 2010. The provision would authorize appropriations at this amount.

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. \_\_\_\_\_**  
**OFFERED BY MS. BORDALLO OF GUAM**

At the appropriate place in title VII, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 7 \_\_\_\_ . MEDICAL CARE IN GUAM FOR CERTAIN CIVIL-**  
2 **IANS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—

4 (1) MEDICAL CARE.—The Secretary of Defense  
5 shall provide medical care at military treatment fa-  
6 cilities in Guam to civilian patients who are referred  
7 to such facilities pursuant to subsection (b).

8 (2) TRANSPORTATION AND FEES.—In providing  
9 medical care under this section, the Secretary shall  
10 ensure that such care—

11 (A) includes transportation to the military  
12 treatment facility; and

13 (B) is provided on a nonreimbursable  
14 basis.

15 (b) MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING.—The Sec-  
16 retary and the Government of Guam shall enter into a  
17 memorandum of understanding regarding the referral of  
18 civilian patients from a civilian hospital in Guam to a mili-

1 tary treatment facility in Guam. Such patients shall be  
2 citizens of—

- 3 (1) the Federated States of Micronesia;  
4 (2) the Republic of the Marshall Islands; or  
5 (3) the Republic of Palau.

6 (c) REPORT.—Not later than April 1, 2011, the Sec-  
7 retary shall submit to the congressional defense commit-  
8 tees a report detailing—

- 9 (1) the number of patients provided medical  
10 care under this section; and  
11 (2) the type and level of such care.

12 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is  
13 authorized to be appropriated \$5,000,000 to carry out this  
14 section.
