Dear Congressman Rush,

The Village of Orland Park requests \$1,500,000 in Federal funding to finance a portion of a comprehensive flooding project, which will address the re-grading and cleaning of Tinley Creek's drainage swales in the Fernway subdivision of the Village of Orland Park, Illinois.

Tinley Creek is a major waterway through the southeast portion of Orland Park. The majority of the creek is privately owned by individual homeowners in the area. The creek is subject to localized flooding in several areas.

Based on the extensive scope of this project, it was divided into four phases. Three of those phases have already been taken on by the Village in an attempt to alleviate the flooding in this area. The fourth phase is being submitted for your consideration for funding.

Phase IV is the final piece to this important project and includes the re-grading and cleaning of drainage swales in front of individual homes that are tributary to Tinley Creek. Fernway Subdivision residents have reported overland flow into homes and yards. Existing culverts under the driveways are undersized, blocked or severely damaged. As a result of the decreased conveyance of the culverts and overland flow routes over the driveway, stormwater ponds form in the shallow ditches in front of these residences and eventually back up into the yards and homes in this area. The Village has \$1,113,780 budgeted for the project in FY11 and is requesting an additional \$1,500,000 in Federal funding through the Water Resources Development Act to help fund curb installation and roadway drainage improvements as part of the project.
