## Dear Madam Speaker and Chairman Obey:

It is becoming increasingly unlikely that the remaining fiscal year 2009 appropriations bills will be considered on the floor of the House of Representatives this session. As you consider legislative options for concluding this year's appropriations process, we write to secure your commitment that any potential continuing resolution or omnibus spending bill (or House report) will not contain any earmarks that have not been debated on the House floor. The cost of these "airdropped" earmarks could total in the billions of dollars.

To date, five appropriations bills including nearly 3,000 earmarks worth more than \$4.5 billion have been favorably reported by the Appropriations Committee. Media reports have also indicated that the ultimate level of spending on earmarks in the fiscal year 2009 appropriation bills could be as high as the \$18.3 billion spent on earmarks last year. Even those who support the practice of earmarking agree that any earmarks that end up in end-of-year spending legislation should be subject to debate on the House floor, similar to those earmarks in the military construction and veterans affairs bill.

Speaker Pelosi, you have indicated your commitment to "auditing the books and subjecting every facet of federal spending to tough budget discipline and accountability." We hope you would agree that allowing earmarks to be approved in spending bills without so much as a cursory vetting on the House floor would be inconsistent with this pledge.
