U.S. CAPITOL VISITOR CENTER Exhibition Hall Cell Phone Tour



The U.S. Capitol Visitor Center's Exhibition Hall showcases the only exhibit in the country solely dedicated to telling the story of Congress and the construction of the U.S. Capitol.

An audio tour of Exhibition Hall is available by using your cell phone to call **202-730-8001**. The Visitor Center does not charge a fee for this service, but you will use your cell phone plan minutes and your cell phone company may apply other usage charges.

The tour begins at the plaster model for the Statue of Freedom, located directly in front of the entrance to Exhibition Hall.

Use your cell phone to listen to the tour at your own pace, controlling the audio with the following keypad commands:

Rewind Fast Forward

2 Pause/Play # Skip
* + 0 Leave Comment



There are 42 stops on the tour, designated by small numbered signs throughout Exhibition Hall that look like this diagram. You may hang up and redial the tour at any time.

This audio tour is also available in languages other than English through handheld audio devices, which are available at the Information Desks in Emancipation Hall. For the visually impaired, an audio description of the Exhibition Hall in English is also available.
