A BILL

To reauthorize certain programs established by the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Adam Walsh Reau-

5 thorization Act of 2012".

6 SEC. 2. SEX OFFENDER MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE (SOMA)

7 **PROGRAM REAUTHORIZATION.**

8 Section 126(d) of the Adam Walsh Child Protection
9 and Safety Act of 2006 (42 U.S.C. 16926(d)) is amended
10 to read as follows:

"(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
 are authorized to be appropriated to the Attorney General
 \$20,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2013 through
 2017, to be available only for—

5 "(1) the SOMA program; and

6 "(2) the Jessica Lunsford Address Verification
7 Grant Program established under section 631.".

8 SEC. 3. REAUTHORIZATION OF FEDERAL ASSISTANCE WITH 9 RESPECT TO VIOLATIONS OF REGISTRATION 10 REQUIREMENTS.

11 Section 142(b) of the Adam Walsh Child Protection 12 and Safety Act of 2006 (42 U.S.C. 16941(b)) is amended 13 by striking "such sums as may be necessary for fiscal 14 years 2007 through 2009" and inserting "\$46,200,000 for 15 each of the fiscal years 2013 through 2017".
