#### **CHAIRMAN KING CONTINUES HEARINGS**

Despite a steady barrage of attacks from special interests and their allies in the liberal media I have continued to follow through on my pledge to conduct hearings on the radicalization of the Muslim-American community. So far this year I have held hearings into the threat we face from efforts by Al Qaeda, Al Shabab and Al Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula (AQAP) to recruit Americans to carry out attacks here at home. These recruiting and radicalization efforts are particularly active in prisons and jails, as well as local communities.

Reaction to the hearings from ordinary Americans has been overwhelmingly positive. There has also been strong support from overseas. The Home Affairs Committee of the British House of Commons decided to hold its own set of radicalization hearings and invited me to testify as the first witness at its initial hearing. This made me the first American Congressman ever to testify in the British Parliament.

I say again that the overwhelming majority of Muslim-Americans are outstanding people. Yet as the President's Deputy National Security Advisor has said: Al Qaeda's "expressed purpose" is to try to "convince Muslim-Americans to reject their country and attack their fellow Americans... This threat is real, and it is serious." As Chairman of the Homeland Security Committee, I must face this reality. I will continue the hearings investigating radicalization.

### CONGRESSMAN KING TESTIFIES IN BRITISH PARLIAMENT

**LONDON, ENGLAND** – Rep. Pete King became the first American Congressman ever to testify in the British Parliament when he appeared before the House of Commons Home Affairs Committee to discuss Islamic radicalization.

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Congressman Pete King appeared on numerous national television shows to discuss his second Muslim radicalization hearing which focused on radicalization in American prisons. Leading law enforcement officials testified about the threat we face from inmates being indoctrinated as extremists and terrorists and then being released back into society.




## CONGRESSMAN KING WORKS TO RESTORE FISCAL INTEGRITY AND CREATE JOBS

For more than three years our country has been enduring severe economic troubles. Unemployment is high. Economic growth is low or non-existent. Consumer confidence continues to decline. Economists warn of another recession. This is particularly true on Long Island where hard-working families are having a difficult time making ends meet and senior citizens are finding it increasingly harder to get by.

To restore economic strength, expand businesses and create jobs, tough decisions must be made. Spending must be cut back at all levels of government. Regulations and red tape must be

reduced. Incentives and rewards for hard work must be restored.

I do not believe that President Obama's policies have worked. The stimulus bill (H.R. 1), for instance, increased the deficit and did not provide relief for middle-income Americans. While there are aspects of the President's Jobs Act (H.R. 12) which have merit, such as focusing on infrastructure spending for bridges, tunnels and highways, I oppose raising taxes because it is counterproductive to increase taxes during an economic downturn. The bottom line is that we must restore fiscal integrity and create jobs. This will not be easy, but it must be done.



## **CONGRESSMAN KING LEADS EFFORT FOR 9/11 HEALTHCARE**

**GROUND ZERO, NY** – Congressman Pete King led the long fight to pass the 9/11 healthcare legislation **(H.R. 847)** which will provide monitoring, care and treatment for the firefighters, police officers, EMS and construction workers who contracted severe and deadly illnesses from their work during the recovery effort at Ground Zero in the days, weeks and months following the 9/11 attacks.
