3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Secondary
5 Payer and Late Enrollment Penalty Family Fairness Act
6 of 2012".

1SEC. 2. FAIR TREATMENT OF FAMILY MEMBERS OF EM-2PLOYEES UNDER MEDICARE SPECIAL EN-3ROLLMENT PERIODS AND UNDER SEC-4ONDARY PAYER RULES.

(a) SPECIAL ENROLLMENT PERIODS.—Paragraphs
(1)(A), (2)(B), and (2)(C) of section 1837(i) of the Social
Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395p(i)) are each amended by
striking "individual's (or the individual's spouse's) current
employment status" and inserting "the individual's current employment status (or the current employment status
of a family member of the individual)".

(b) SECONDARY PAYER RULES.—Section 1862(b) of
such Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(b)) is amended—

14 (1) in paragraph (1)(A)(i)(I), by striking "the
15 individual's spouse" and inserting "a family member
16 of the individual";

17 (2) in paragraph (1)(A)(i)(II), by striking "the
18 spouse" and "(or spouse)" and inserting "a family
19 member" and "(or family member)", respectively;

21 (3) in paragraph (5)(C)(i), by striking "spouse"
22 and inserting "family member".

23 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT TO LATE ENROLL24 MENT PENALTY.—Section 1839(b) of the Social Security
25 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395r(b)) is amended by striking "individ26 ual's (or the individual's spouse's) current employment"

and inserting "the individual's current employment status
 (or the current employment status of a family member of
 the individual)".

4 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by

5 this section shall take effect on January 1, 2013, and shall

6 apply to months beginning on or after such date.
